Dust-binding mopping: the cleaning method of the present and future

Masslinn dust cloths reliably bind dust and germs in the cloth. They feature an impressive area performance up to 2.5 times higher than a vacuum cleaner, as well as versatile use on floors and surfaces. Following is a brief overview of the product variants and the advantages of this future-oriented cleaning method.

Dust-binding mopping:

Efficient and hygienic

Masslinn dust cloths optimally remove loose dirt from floors and surfaces Dust-binding mopping is therefore ideal for daily maintenance cleaning or as preparation for subsequent cleaning methods, such as wet mopping, oiling or scrub drying.

The rule is:

- 1. Remove loose dirt daily / regularly (Masslinn cloths)
- 2. If necessary, remove stubborn dirt (subsequent cleaning method).




Dust-binding mopping vs. vacuum cleaning: Which method covers more area per hour?

In a practical comparison, the methods achieve the following area performance (smooth floor covering, free area):

Vacuum cleaning (conventional dry vacuum cleaner):



approx. **300** m²/h Dust-binding mopping (dust cloths & mop):



approx. 600-800 m²/h

Conclusion: With dust-binding mopping, cleaners cover twice as much surface area per hour.

C2C environmental label and FIGR certificate: Masslinn cloths are eco-friendly and effective

Eco-friendly disposable cloths? Yes! The Masslinn cloths have been awarded a well-known environmental seal: the Cradle-to-Cradle certification® (Bronze). The Masslinn dust cloths from Wetrok are sustainable and still perform their main function just as well: removing dust thoroughly. Masslinn cloths have been tested in strict comparison tests carried out by the FIGR research and certification institute. The result: top marks when it comes to dust removal, cleaning performance and germ reduction.

Cradle-to-Cradle: what does this mean?



The Cradle-to-Cradle Label® (C2C) follows a holistic approach for the assessment of products.

All Masslinn cloths (with the exception of Masslinn orange) are Cradle-to-Cradle certified. When awarding the label, ecological and social factors are reviewed:

- Are the **ingredients** safe for people and the environment?
- Is the product biodegradable or can it be recycled as part of the biological or technical cycle?
- How much energy is used in production and is renewable energy used?
- Does the manufacturer use raw materials responsibly in their production processes?
- Does the manufacturer adhere to social principles and allow these to be verified by third parties?

The label is award in five categories: basic, bronze, silver, gold and platinum. Masslinn dust cloths are currently qualified for a bronze certification.

FIGR-tested: what does this mean?



The Research and Testing Institute for Facility Management (German abbreviation: FIGR) tests cleaning implements to determine their quality and effectiveness. In the tests, Masslinn dust cloths were certified for high effectiveness against dust and germs as well as excellent cleaning

performance. The two most important test results from the laboratory and comparison tests:

- When cleaning personnel use Masslinn cloths for dust-binding mopping in combination with wet cleaning or disinfection, they achieve maximum germ reduction and optimum cleaning results (over 90 % dirt removal).
- Dust-binding mopping with Masslinn allows cleaning personnel to achieve significantly higher germ reduction than with wet mopping/scrub drying alone.

According to the official FIGR certificate, Masslinn dust cloths are "highly recommended" for dust-binding mopping (original quotation).



Dust-binding mopping: 10 advantages

Dust-binding mopping is unsuitable for heavily soiled or textured floor coverings and textiles. In these areas, continue to use dry vacuum cleaners.

Dust-binding mopping:

the hygienic cleaning method for floor cleaning

With dust-binding mopping, Wetrok has developed a method to put dust in its place.

Three unbeatable hygiene reasons for dust-binding mopping with Masslinn disposable cloths:

1. No airborne dust:

Masslinn cloths do not stir up dust (= no germ distribution)

2. No cross-contamination:

Changing rooms means changing cloths (1 cloth, 1 room).

3. No dust residues:


Masslinn dust cloths remove almost 100 % of dust and loose dirt.



Why is dust dangerous? Dust should not be underestimated, because...

- ... **80** % of all soiling in a building consists of dust.
- ... 1 gram of dust contains up to 1.5 million germs.
- ... Dust is a carrier for dangerous microorganisms, bacteria and viruses (risk of infection).
- ... Dust can be **harmful** to **health** (e.g. cause asthma or allergies).

To prevent health problems, even the smallest, barely visible dust particles must therefore be removed. The basic rule for maximum hygiene is: First, remove germ-containing dust with Masslinn cloths, then wet wipe or scrub (if there is stubborn dirt).


