Hard types of stone, e.g. granite, gneiss, quartzite and porphyry, are largely acid resistant.
Sensitive or resistant against acid means against amidosulphuric acid.
The polish can be sensitive to acids or alkalines. Test in an inconspicuous place!
There must be no coating in the open air and in wet rooms. Danger of slipping!
Fats and oils can penetrate into the stone covering. Stain formation!
Soak the joints well or saturate them with an alkali cleaning solution before removing cement residue or limescale.



Natural stone is a 100% natural product consisting of minerals such as quartz, feldspar, calcite, selenite, hornblende or mica. The colour and the appearance of the stone varies depending on its origin.

Distinguishing feature: natural stone acid-proof acid assay: apply a little basic sanitary cleaner to the stone covering, does not foam up.



Remove loose dirt before every cleaning, damp mop smooth floors and vacuum structured floors. Cleaning agents and surface treatments may alter the appearance and properties of a floor's surface. Test on an inconspicuous spot to find which product is suitable for your requirements. Test beforehand on an inconspicuous spot to see if the cleaning agent or surface treatment damages the floor. Dirt-trapping zones, incl. dirt-trapping mats (Wetrok Gardamat) in the entrance, at least 7m long, greatly reduce the amount of dirt tracked into the building.
