CV floor coverings are sensitive to cigarette burns, single-disc machines and deposit marks.

CV floor coverings are sensitive to certain solvents such as ketone and ester.

Because of their minimal heat insulation, only smooth CV floor coverings can be spray cleaned. Low speed!

Fat-soluble colorants such as shoe polish or asphalt can penetrate into CV floor coverings: diffusion.



CV floor coverings are plastic composites with a homogeneous, transparent, smooth or structured plastic use-surface, mostly made from polyurethane. CV floor coverings are given attractive designs, such as parquet, stone or linoleum, under the use-surface through multi-colour prints. Danger of confusion! The lower or intermediate layers consist of foamed plastic (PVC with softeners).

Depending on the manufacturer, the base layers consist of bonded cloth, synthetic cloth, synthetic foam, felt or cork (previously asbestos).

Distinguishing feature: fire assay with a glowing hot needle in an inconspicuous place: the needle penetrates, acrid smell, crater cannot be removed with fingers.



Remove loose dirt before every cleaning, damp mop smooth floors and vacuum structured floors.

Cleaning agents and surface treatments may alter the appearance and properties of a floor's surface.

Test on an inconspicuous spot to find which product is suitable for your requirements.

Test beforehand on an inconspicuous spot to see if the cleaning agent or surface treatment damages the floor.

Dirt-trapping zones, incl. dirt-trapping mats (Wetrok Gardamat) in the entrance, at least 7m long, greatly reduce the amount of dirt tracked into the building.
